




FYI: Understand Your Progress

If your courses have due dates, you'll see color-coded bars for each of your courses when you first log in. These bars tell you how much work you've done in the course. If your courses don't have due dates, you won't see this color coding. This color coding is only for regular courses, not Flex assignments or Assessments.

Remember, these color codes only tell you **how much** of the course work you've finished. They don't tell you how well you're doing. You could be ahead of pace, but if you're not passing your mastery tests, you may be at risk of not passing the course. Keep an eye on your current grade too.



Dark green: Ahead of pace. If you're passing your mastery tests, you're doing great! Keep doing what you're doing, and you should have no problem finishing the course on time.

Light green: On pace. If you're passing your mastery tests, you're doing just fine. Keep it up, and you'll finish the course on time.

Orange: Slightly off pace. You have a little catching up to do. If you pick up the pace a bit, you should finish the course on time.

Pink: Off pace. Right now, you're not on track to finish the course on time. Maybe you just need to spend more time working on the course to catch up, or maybe you need to ask your teacher for help.






FYI: Understand Your Progress

As you work through the course, the activity tiles change color.



Map Skills

Gray: Not Started.



Blue: In Progress. This is a module that you haven't finished or a graded activity that your teacher hasn't graded



Green: Completed. Graded activities change to Completed when your teacher grades your work.



The United States: Regions, States, and Cities 60%



Green with a yellow star: Completed and Mastered. You have completed the tutorial and earned a passing grade on the mastery test.

Yellow: Completed but Not Mastered. Ask your teacher what to do with these modules. Some teachers want you to redo the module and master it.

Green with a blue star: Exempt. You automatically earn 100% on this module. You can still look at it if you want to when you're preparing for tests.

Use the new filter bar at the top of the course home page to sort your course activities.
