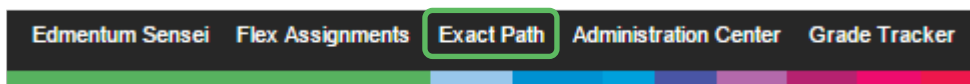




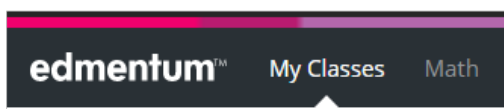
Set Up Easy Login

Easy Login is a feature that allows students to log into Exact Path using a picture password instead of a traditional username and password. This feature is ideal for younger students, who may have trouble with username-and-password combinations, but a class at any grade level can use Easy Login. Easy Login is available **after** the class is created in Exact Path, not during the class-creation process.

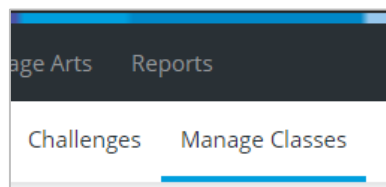
1. Click **Exact Path** from the top of the home page.



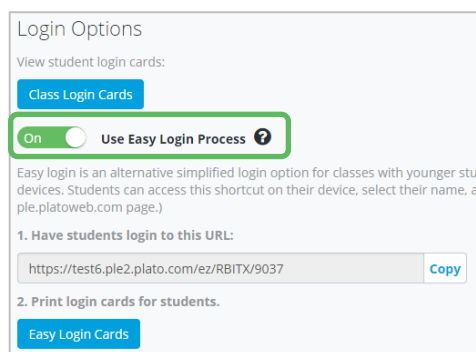
2. Click **My Classes**.



3. Click **Manage Classes**.



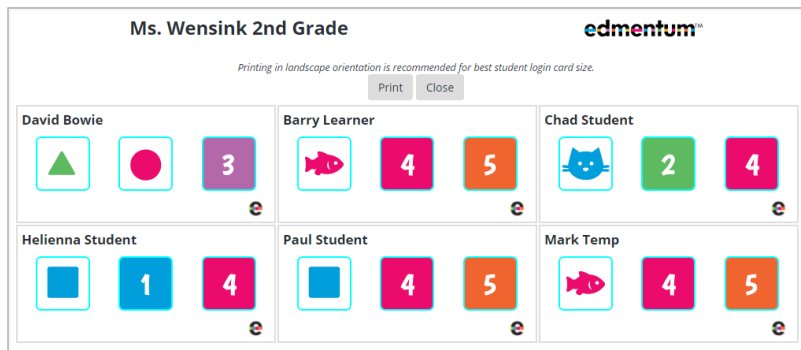
4. Click on the class name from your list of classes.
5. Under **Login Options**, toggle the **Use Easy Login Process** button to **On**.



Exact Path generates a unique URL for the class.



- Students use this URL rather than the standard Edmentum URL to access the class. We recommend bookmarking this URL to each student's device.
- Click **Easy Login Cards** to print cards with each student's login code. Give these cards to your students to help them remember their codes.



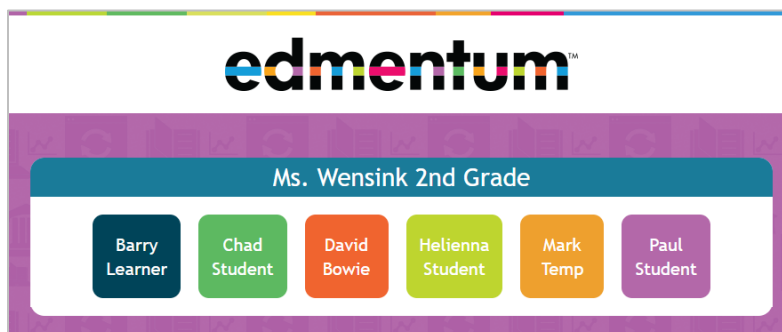
- Click **Save Class**.

Note: Each student's login code is linked to the student's original username and password as they were originally entered in the Administration Center. Therefore, we recommend unique passwords so that students will have unique Easy Login codes.

To reset a student's Easy Login code, Administrators need to reset the student's original username and password in the Administration Center.

Student View of Easy Login

- Students go to your class's unique URL and see a list of students in the class.
