**Create Users** 

#### To create individual users:

- 1. Click **Administration Center** (top of the page).
- 2. From the **Users** drop-down, click **Manage**.
- 3. Click Create a User.
- 4. Enter the user's information, including login credentials and location.
- 5. Click **Save & Return to Users** if you are done adding users or **Save & Create Another User** to add additional users.

### To batch import users:

- 1. Click **Administration Center** (top of the page).
- 2. From the **Users** drop-down, click **Batch Processing**.
- 3. Click **File Format Specifications** to view the requirements for entering data.
- 4. Click **Download a Sample File**.

This Excel file is populated with all the categories of information you can upload.

- 5. Populate the sample file with data from your location, and save the file to your computer.
- 6. From the **Batch Processing** screen, click **Upload**.
- 7. Click **Browse**, locate your file, and click **Open**.
- 8. Click **Import the Selected File** to begin the batch process.

- 1. Click **Exact Path** (top of the page).
- 2. Click **Settings** (top right of the page).
- 3. Click Academic Years.
- 4. Click +Add year.
- 5. Select the year's type, name, start date, and end date.
- 6. Click **Save**.
- 7. Under the **Standards** Setup heading, select your standards for Math and Reading and Language Arts. These settings are automatically saved.





Schedule a **Diagnostic Testing** Window

NOTE: You must define the academic year before scheduling a diagnostic testing window.

- 1. After defining your academic years, click **Test Windows**.
- 2. Select the **Academic Year** from the drop-down (top right side of the page).
- 3. Click +Add Test Window, enter the Test Windows dates, and click Save.
- 4. Click +Add Benchmark Window, enter test window dates, and click **Save**.
- 5. Optional: Customize hours tests are accessible in the **Test** Availability section.

Schedule a Diagnostic Test

NOTE: You must schedule the diagnostic testing window before scheduling a diagnostic test.

- 1. Choose the subject (Math, Reading, or Language Arts) that the diagnostic test will cover.
- 2. Click Diagnostic Scheduling.
- 3. Select the class or location and the **Academic Year** to be scheduled.
- 4. Select the students who will take the diagnostic, and click Schedule.
- 5. Set the date and time the test will be available to students, and click **Schedule**.

Note: For Exact Path to function correctly, students' devices must allow pop-ups.



View Student Diagnostic **Results** 

- 1. Select a subject (Math, Language Arts, or Reading).
- 2. Select **Class Diagnostic Results** and select the appropriate diagnostic.
- 3. To view individual student results in the Student Summary Report, click a student's name.



**Monitor** Student **Progress**  The Knowledge Map allows you to monitor student performance, growth and progress in their learning paths.

- 1. Choose the subject (Math, Reading, or Language Arts) to monitor.
- 2. Click **Knowledge Map**. Use the directional arrows to view the skills.
